- The memory of the righteous is in praise. And for you, Forerunner, the testimony of the Lord sufficed: for in truth you have been revealed as nobler than all the Prophets. For having been considered worthy to baptise in running waters Him who was preached. Therefore, you strove for the truth happily. You proclaimed to those in Hades God appearing in the body, Who takes away the sin of the world, and Who grants us the Great Mercy.
- Through you O ever-Virgin Theotokos, we have become partakers of the divine nature, for you gave birth to the incarnate God for our sake. Therefore, we all devoutly exalt you!

Wednesday and Friday:

- O Lord, save Your people, and bless Your inheritance, granting to Your People victory over all adversaries, and by Your Cross preserving Your Estate.
- We have acquired your protection, O pure one. We have been redeemed by your supplications, and we have been guarded always by the cross of your Son. Therefore, we all rightly exalt you.



Thursda y:

- O Holy Apostles, intercede with the merciful God, to grant our souls forgivenes s of sins.
- The truth of your dealings, Our Father and Bishop Nicholas, showed you to your flock as the standard of faith, as the image of gentleness, and as a teacher of self-discipline. Have mercy on me, O God, in Your enduring goodness: according to the fullness of Your compassion blot out my offences.


